January General Meeting Notes

Jan 17, 2006

1). The Prop H lawsuit may be heard in a San Francisco court on Feb 15, 2006. In the meantime, the City of San Francisco has agreed to postpone enforcement of a provision of Prop H that bans the sale or transfer of firearms or ammunition until March 1, 2006. The handgun possession provision of the ban is scheduled to take effect on April 1, 2006.

2). The California Legislature is back in session. We expect the “Ammunition Serialization” bill, the “Micro-imprinting on cases” bill, and the lead ammunition ban to be back on the table. We will alert you to action when the time is right. Remember our “**one-click**” system?

3). We have plenty of volunteer opportunities. We always need help at the NRA gunshow booth. We also need NRA –certified pistol instructors for the NRA Women On Target introduction courses.
